## DAILY COVID-19 PATIENT STATS

Today's census for COVID-19 inpatients and those patients under investigation (PUI) are noted below:

COVID-19 Patient Percent Positivity (7 day moving average), as of 1/11

Symptomatic testing: 14.36 %

Asymptomatic testing: 1.68 %

**Discharges:** 1,466 total COVID-19 discharges to date, 4 in the last 24 hours. These numbers include patients discharged to skilled nursing facilities but excludes deaths and discharges to hospice.

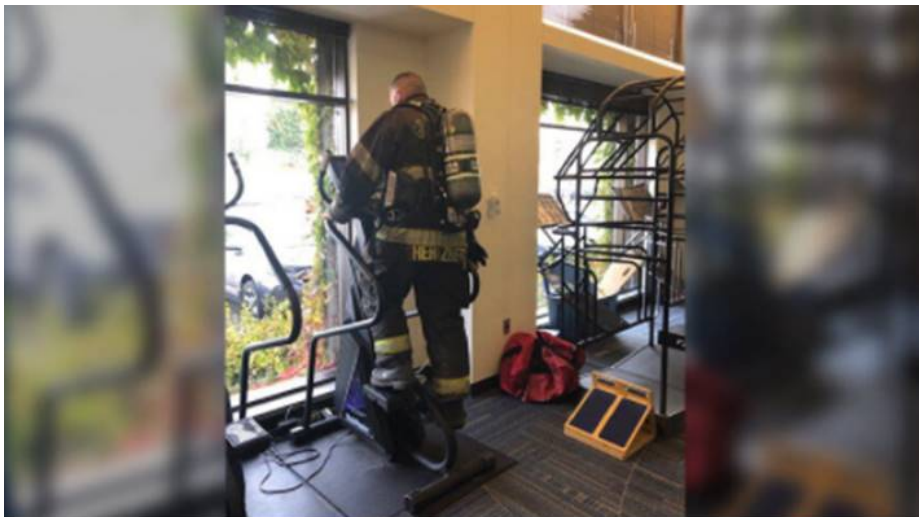
