DAILY COVID-19 PATIENT STATS

Today's census for COVID-19 inpatients and those patients under investigation (PUI) are noted below:

COVID-19 Patient Percent Positivity (7 day moving average)

Symptomatic testing: 19.04%

Asymptomatic testing: 2.09%

Discharges: 1,481 total COVID-19 discharges to date, 8 in the last 24 hours. These numbers include patients discharged to skilled nursing facilities but excludes deaths and discharges to hospice.

Deaths and hospice: Since March 10, Michigan Medicine hospitals have had 206 total deaths or discharges to hospice, 2 in the last 24 hours.

Number of vaccines administered to our community (yesterday)	1,112
Number of vaccine appointments currently scheduled (today through 1/12)	3,309
Number of people sent invitations yesterday	4,600
