## DAILY COVID-19 PATIENT STATS

Today's census for COVID-19 inpatients and those patients under investigation (PUI) are noted below:

COVID-19 Patient Percent Positivity (7 day moving average)

Symptomatic testing: 4.92%

Asymptomatic testing: 0.84%

**Discharges:** 1,757 total COVID-19 discharges to date, 6 in the last 24 hours. These numbers include patients discharged to skilled nursing facilities but excludes deaths and discharges to hospice.

**Deaths and hospice:** Since March 10, Michigan Medicine hospitals have had 229 total deaths or discharges to hospice, 0 in the last 24 hours.

\*The number of doses received and administered may differ because each Pfizer multidose vial contains a minimum of 5 doses (officially reported as received), but often our vaccinators are able to draw 1-2 extra doses from the vials. #### TOWN HALL FAQs

##### Will we be required to come in the office as of April 1st?

At this time, the remote working guidelines extend through March, 2021. Discussions are occurring on whether that timeframe will be extended, and we hope to have an announcement soon.

**Are there any non-patient facing COVID vaccination volunteer opportunities?**

Most volunteer roles are patient-facing. At this time, volunteer opportunities within the COVID vaccine clinic are limited due to an overwhelming response, and the limited hours of operation for clinics. If you submitted an interest form to volunteer, you will be notified when a spot is available.

**Will faculty be able to accrue unused vacation time in the same way those on PTO programs are allowed to do? And, will that unused vacation time be paid out when a faculty member leaves or retires?**

Faculty should refer to SPG 201.64-1 or SPG 201.64.0 for vacation time inquiries. Departments are not required to pay out accrued vacation time when faculty leave the University of Michigan.

**What was the process to select people for the AROC sub-committees? How do people apply or express interest in being involved?**

The Anti-Racism Oversight Committee includes broad representation across Michigan Medicine. Committee members were originally recommended by leaders of those areas. While the committee is not currently accepting new committee members, there may be an opportunity to work with the committee as they move into the Implementation Phase of the Action Plans. **Is there any plan in the future to have an application process and timeframe/term to help rotate the members in those AROC sub-committees rather than having the same folks?**
