DAILY COVID-19 PATIENT STATS

Today's census for COVID-19 inpatients and those patients under investigation (PUI) are noted below:

COVID-19 Patient Percent Positivity (7 day moving average), as of 3/8

Symptomatic testing: 4.75 %

Asymptomatic testing: 0.52%

Discharges: 1,887 total COVID-19 discharges to date, 10 in the last 24 hours. These numbers include patients discharged to skilled nursing facilities but excludes deaths and discharges to hospice.

Deaths and hospice: Since March 10, 2020 Michigan Medicine hospitals have had 233 total deaths or discharges to hospice, 0 in the last 24 hours.

NEW CDC GUIDELINES FOR HOME SETTINGS ONLY

Recently, the CDC issues [additional guidelines](#) for social interactions for people who have been fully vaccinated. NITRILE GLOVE SUPPLIERS

Due to the global pandemic and global supply shortages, many substitutions continue to be necessary to meet staff and patient care needs. Supply Chain has needed to go beyond our

current suppliers to acquire adequate nitrile exam glove supply from additional vendors. Please note that all gloves from various vendors are vetted through Value Analysis to assure all IP&E and Safety guidelines are followed meeting ASTM-D-6978-05 standards.
