Today’s census for COVID-19 inpatients and those patients under investigation (PUI) are noted below:

Symptomatic testing 11.14 %

Asymptomatic testing: 1.78 %

Discharges: 2,516 total COVID-19 discharges to date, 3 in the last 24 hours. These numbers include patients discharged to skilled nursing facilities but excludes deaths and discharges to hospice.
