Symptomatic testing 15.40%

Asymptomatic testing: 2.39%

Discharges: 2,370 total COVID-19 discharges to date, 8 in the last 24 hours. These numbers include patients discharged to skilled nursing facilities but excludes deaths and discharges to hospice.
