**DAILY COVID-19 PATIENT STATS**

Today's census for COVID-19 inpatients and those patients under investigation (PUI) are noted below:

Symptomatic testing: 21.53 %

Asymptomatic testing: 2.79%

**Discharges:** 2,301 total COVID-19 discharges to date, 18 in the last 24 hours. These numbers include patients discharged to skilled nursing facilities but excludes deaths and discharges to hospice.

**Deaths and hospice:** Since March 10, 2020 Michigan Medicine hospitals have had 246 total deaths or discharges to hospice, 1 in the last 24 hours.

## **EMPLOYEE VACCINATION RATES**

Currently, Michigan Medicine estimates that at least 70-75% of employees have been vaccinated. However, there are no records for those who were vaccinated at the VA, out of state, or at retail pharmacies or other locations outside of Michigan Medicine.

## **NATIONAL VACCINE CAMPAIGN**

Michigan Medicine is collaborating with a coalition of 60 of America's top hospitals and health care institutions on a nationwide campaign to encourage adults to get vaccinated for COVID-19. Led by Cleveland Clinic and Mayo Clinic, the campaign "[Get the Vaccine to Save Lives](#)," is designed to reassure the public that vaccines are safe, effective and necessary to achieve herd immunity and a return to normal activities.

## **WALK-IN VACCINE CLINIC AT STADIUM**

Michigan Medicine is opening the Michigan Stadium vaccination clinic to 1<sup>st</sup>-dose walk-ins on Friday, April 23 from 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Any individual age 16 and older with a Michigan Medicine Medical Record Number (MRN) is eligible for the walk-in clinic; the MRN must be presented at the door. The walk-in clinic cannot offer 2<sup>nd</sup> dose appointments; only individuals who have not yet received a first dose administration are eligible. Michigan Medicine supervisors and managers are asked to be flexible and accommodate staff who want to take advantage of this and other vaccination opportunities.

## **REMINDERS FOR SYMPTOMATIC EMPLOYEES**

Please be reminded that if you are experiencing any symptoms of illness, you should not report to work and should contact [Occupational Health Services](#) to determine if you meet the criteria for COVID-19 testing. As the number of COVID-19 cases continues to rise in our community and across the state, it is important for all employees to follow [specific guidelines](#) if they experience symptoms of COVID-19.
