COVID-19 SUMMIT WEBINAR JUNE 14

The Mi-COVID-19 Initiative Joint CQI Venture is hosting a COVID-19 Summit webinar in partnership with the Michigan Health & Hospital Association (MHA) and the Michigan Chapter of the Society of Critical Care Medicine (SCCM-MI) on Monday, June 14, from 9 to 11 a.m. Registration for the webinar is required.

This summit aims to share key findings and pivotal lessons learned from the Mi-COVID-19 data registry and to review the current state of COVID-19 in the state of Michigan. A session dedicated to public policy in pandemics will be led by the Michigan Health & Hospital Association. Another session focused on adult and pediatric critical care will be a panel discussion led by the Michigan Chapter of the Society of Critical Care Medicine.
